

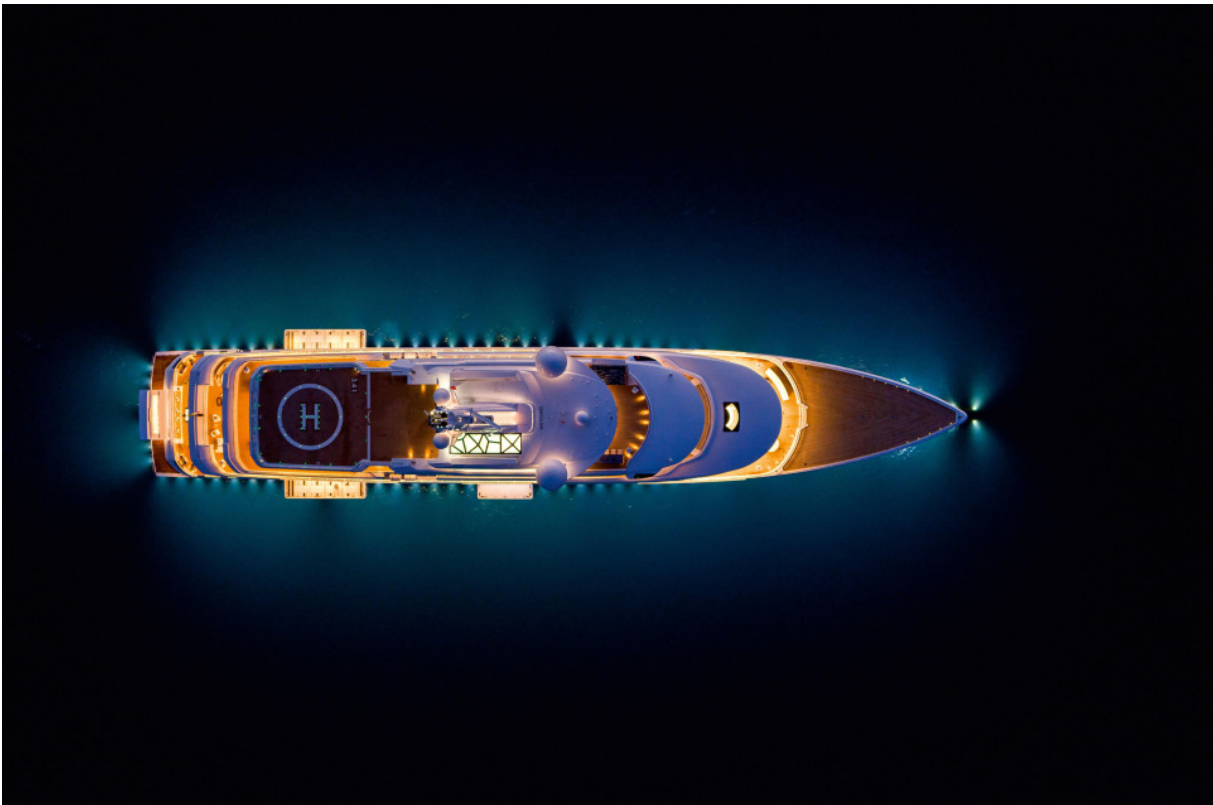

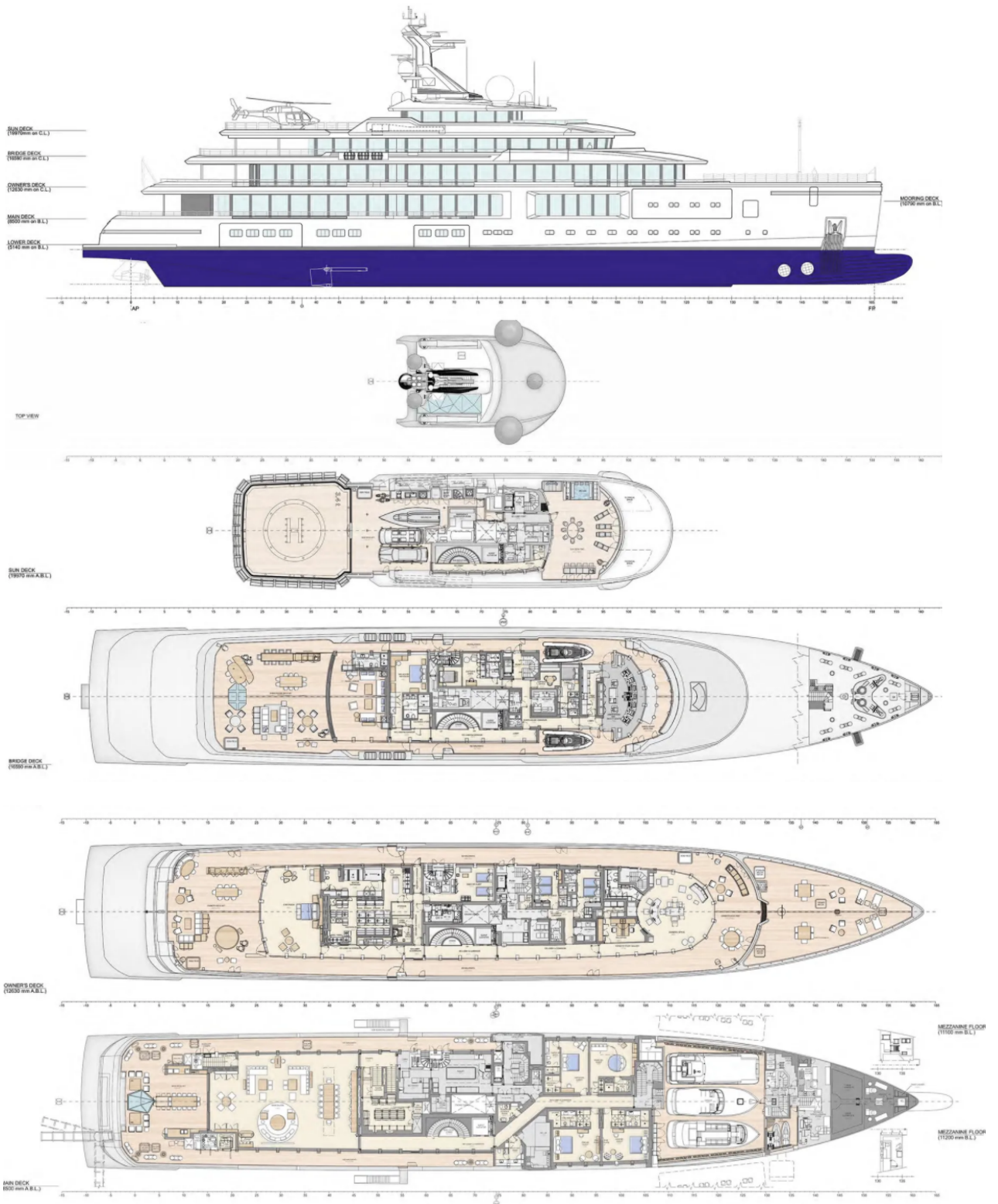

SUMMARY

LUMINOSITY is a 107.6-meter luxury superyacht built by Benetti during its Giga Season. With a beam of 17 meters and six expansive decks, the yacht is designed to offer a seamless blend of innovation, sustainability, and artistic elegance. Its eye-catching exterior is the result of a creative collaboration between Zaniz Jakubowski, Andrew Langton, and Giorgio M. Cassetta. Inspired by the concept of a "moving palace of glass," LUMINOSITY features extra-clear three-meter-tall windows and glazed surfaces that flood the interiors with natural light, creating breathtaking panoramic views.

Inside, the yacht embraces art in every detail, paying tribute to renowned artists like Damien Hirst, Man Ray, and Matisse. The Main Deck Lobby showcases colored circles reminiscent of Hirst's work, while Man Ray's eye-shaped construction and Matisse-inspired backlit ceiling cut-outs add a unique artistic touch. A striking digital art display along the main staircase spans 370 meters, where interactive projections of swaying forests and blooming magnolia flowers respond to guests' movements. The VIP suite on the Upper Deck further enhances the experience with an onyx sculpture that replicates the changing phases of the moon, casting a dreamy glow throughout the space.

Technologically advanced, LUMINOSITY is powered by a state-of-the-art hybrid propulsion system featuring diesel-electric engines and two 2,200 kW Azipods. Its 3 megawatt-hour lithium-polymer battery bank allows for up to 12 hours of silent, emission-free cruising with the generators switched off. The fully integrated Power Management System ensures optimal energy efficiency, reducing environmental impact without compromising performance. Additionally, the yacht boasts an advanced connectivity system and fingerprint recognition for access to private areas, setting a new standard in yacht security and convenience.

Safety and comfort are also at the core of LUMINOSITY's design. The yacht is equipped with superior-quality fire-proof and fire-retardant materials, as well as an onboard medical center to handle emergencies. With a vibration-free, ultra-stable cruising experience and an unrivaled audio-video system, M/Y LUMINOSITY represents the perfect balance of technology, sustainability, and luxury, redefining the future of yachting.
